



New Yorkers Agree: NY Ticketing Law Protects Consumers and Should be Renewed

Poll finds overwhelming support for the renewal of New York's ticketing law; New York consumers want ticket transferability to be preserved


If you do not use your tickets to a concert or game, should you have the freedom & choice to do what you want with your tickets, like reselling them or giving them away?







Methodology: 500 New York adults ages 18+ were surveyed by Google Surveys from April 16, 2021 through April 29, 2021.
